

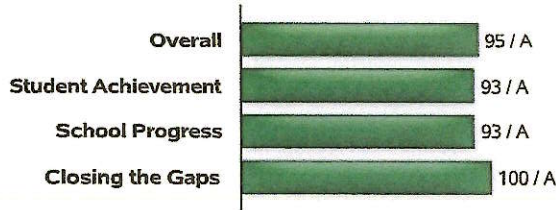

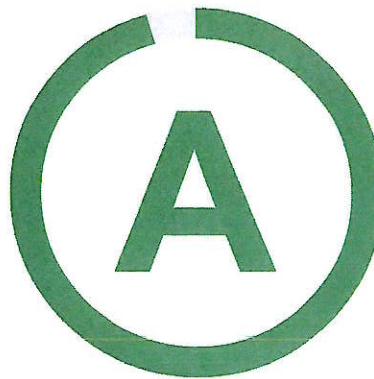

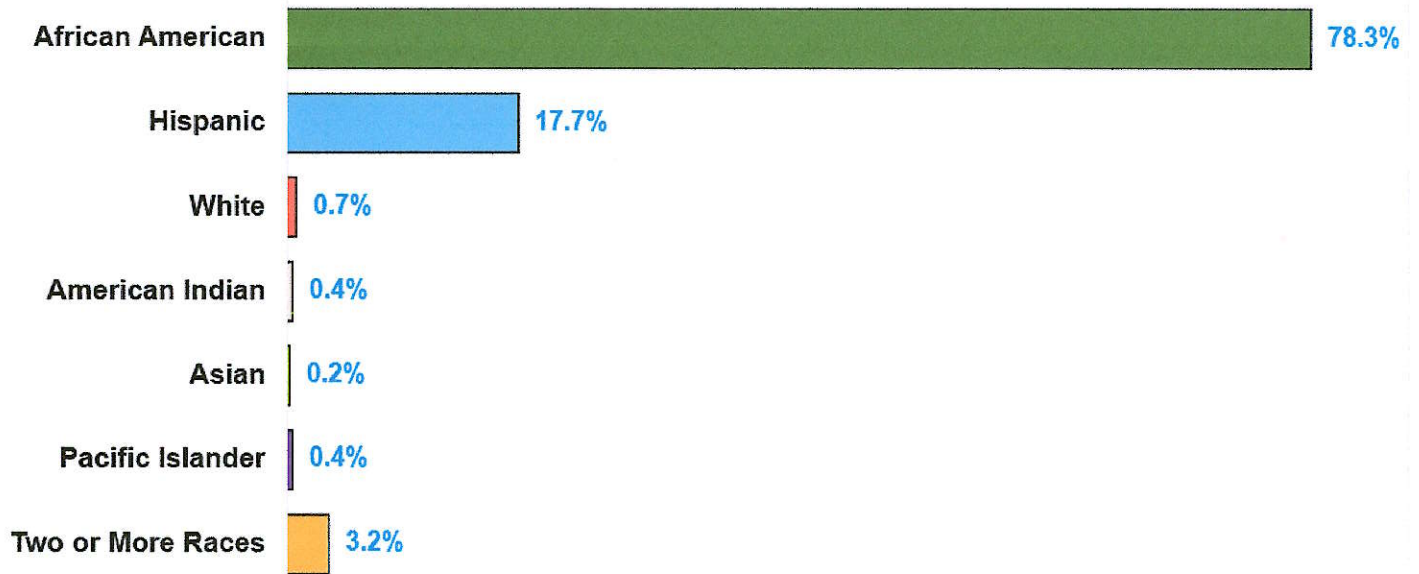

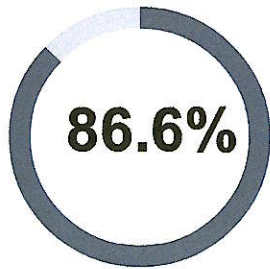

Student Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity

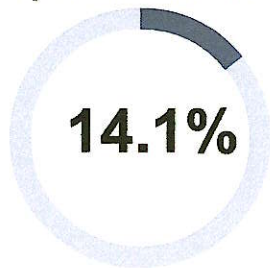


Student Enrollment by Type

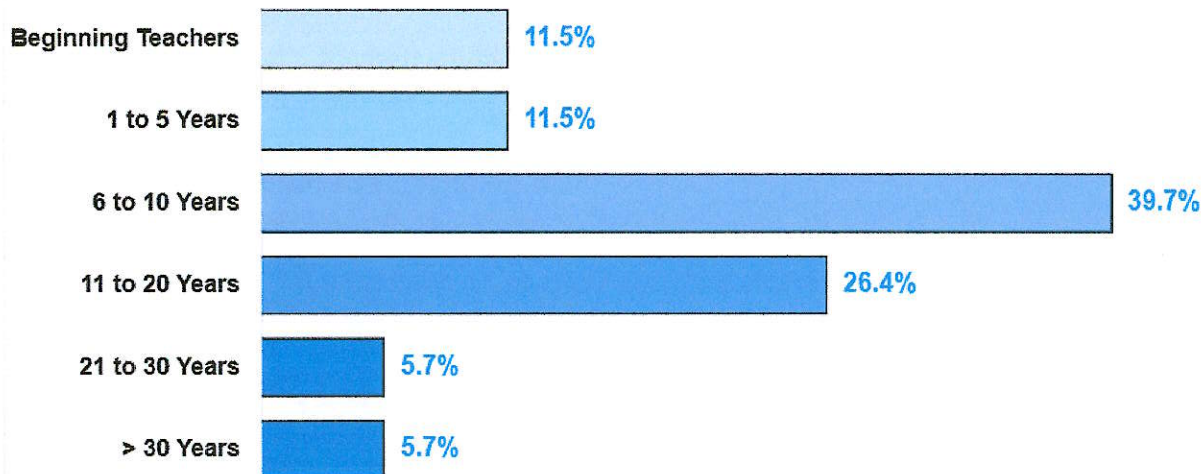

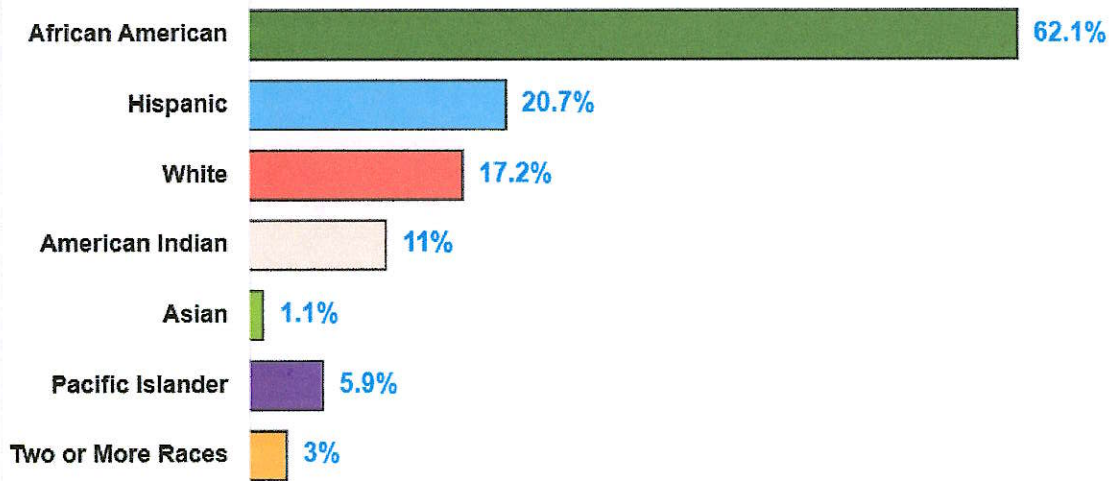
